AKC NEWS

The Board reviewed a request from the Herding, Earthdog and Coursing Delegate Committee to add a new stake to Lure Coursing Trials called a Singles Stake. Hounds are run by themselves, scored and placements are determined on the basis of the score. All dogs that enter the Singles Stake compete against each other regardless of breed. Results are recorded to a dog's record but no title is earned. Offering the stake is at the discretion of the host club. This will be discussed further at the July meeting of the AKC Board of Directors.

The *AKC Gazette & Events* will be reformatted, transitioning from a print magazine to a PDF document posted monthly to the AKC web site. Effective with the October, 2011 issue, this new *AKC Gazette* would include the Chairman's and President's letters, AKC Updates, the Parent Club breed columns (these columns will be enhanced with links to the Parent Clubs' web sites), and the Secretary's Pages. This electronic version of the *AKC Gazette* would be available for free. Subscribers who currently pay for the print edition will have the subscription converted to *Family Dog* or the option of a pro-rata refund. The AKC Delegate and Board meeting minutes will continue to be posted on the AKC web site. The Show Awards CD will be replaced by online reports that will be available through the web site, effective in January 2012.

The Board approved a new rule: Cell Phone and Electronic Devices. Judges may use electronic devices including cell phones to review written breed standards while at their judges' table. Such electronic devices when not in use must remain on the judge's table or in its vicinity in a bag or briefcase. Judge should not walk away from the table with an electronic device in hand while judging. Neither the judge, ring steward nor an exhibitor may initiate or receive any phone calls and/or text messages while in the ring.

The Norrbottenspet is added to the list of breeds eligible to participate in Lure Coursing Test and Trials effective 7-2011.

How does the AKC determine the dog and bitch counts necessary for attaining certain sets of points for the different divisions each year? The point schedule is based upon a set of percentages using the previous three years' actual dogs in competition. This was changed, to a single year calculation beginning with the 2011-2012 Schedule of Points. Also changed, the AKC now removes all independent and designated Specialties held by National breed Parent Clubs, as well as the local shows held three days prior to the AKC/Eukanuba National Championship, from the data base used to make the calculations for the 2011-2012 Schedule of Points. It is calculated so that a certain percentage of the shows where there was an actual competition for a particular sex of a particular breed or variety will carry a certain number of championship points. The percentages are as follows for Divisions 1-9, 13, & 14:

1 Point - 95% of the shows where there was competition for a sex of a breed will carry at least one championship point.

2 Points - The two-point break is set midway between the one- and three-point breaks.

3 Points - The three-point break is set so that as close as possible to 18%. There will never be more than 20% of the shows in each division offering major points (3, 4 or 5 points.)

4 Points - The four-point break is set at one-third of the difference between the three- and five-point breaks.

5 Points - At least 1%, but less than 2% of the shows offering competition for a particular sex of a particular breed, will carry five championship points.
